After some time negotiating with Wingecarribee Shire Council, REPS obtained the use of this vacant land to become Pinkwood Park. In 2001, it was opened by the then Mayor Phil Yeo. A large crowd celebrated the opening and Robertson school children planted the first Pinkwoods (*Eucryphia moorei*) and other trees as part of federation plantings. With more grants, a sign and a fence were erected. A lot of work and plantings have continued since.

This second opening recognises plant growth, improvements and now the installation of bench seats by REPS with funds from a Council grant. The seats have beautiful engravings of Pinkwood leaves, taken from drawings by Robertson school children. Many other children will take a short time off school to celebrate this special opening and enjoy the park.
